



DEEP RIVER WATERPARK

For all Group Leaders, please read the following and plan ahead!

- Deep River Waterpark is open from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Central Time. Entrances to rides close at 5:45pm.
- One responsible chaperone (18 or older) will be required per 10 children (age 13 and under). Chaperones are required to stay with their group members and supervise them properly. Failing to comply with this can result in immediate removal of your entire group.
- To help speed up the check-in process, please collect all money from your group members prior to arriving and bring a copy of this confirmation with you.
- Your entire group must arrive at the same time. The leader will make a ONE time purchase of tickets for the entire group. You will then distribute the tickets to your group members and they can enter the waterpark through the group sales gate.
- Acceptable methods of payment include Cash, Check (with driver's license), Visa, MasterCard, AmEx, or Discover.
- After payment is made by the leader, no refunds are allowed.
- All special billing arrangements must be requested and approved 14 days in advance of your trip.
- Tables inside Deep River Waterpark are available on a first-come basis. Consider renting a shelter area for your group. Check our website for all info deepriverwaterpark.com or talk to your group sales contact.
- If arriving by bus, the bus may unload in front of the group entrance. The bus driver should park at the far end of the lot once everyone has unloaded. Bus drivers are welcome to enter the park free of charge, as long as they do not participate in any water activities.
- Deep River Waterpark has made arrangements to offer groups discount rates at the area's finest hotels. Ask your group sales contact for more information on our Lodging Packages.
- All day lockers are available to rent on a first-come basis at the following rates: \$6.00 standard, \$7.00 large, \$10.00 jumbo.
- Tubes are provided for all rides that require them, as they come available. Should you wish to have a personal tube, single tubes are available to rent for \$5.00.
- If your entire group has a catered meal, you will save 5% off your total admission charges.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR ENTIRE GROUP IS AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION!

- Groups need to arrive at the same time unless previous arrangements have been made.
- Carry-in coolers are permitted in designated areas and will be inspected prior to admission. Alcoholic beverages, anything sharp, heating units of any kind, and any and all glass will not be allowed anywhere on park property and must be removed prior to admission. We cannot store anything.
- For your safety large umbrellas, grills, whistles, floatation devices, and weapons of any kind are not allowed anywhere on park property.
- Only appropriate swimwear and attire is permitted. No cut-offs, swimwear with metal buckles or rivets, or offensive clothing is not allowed.
- Life vests are available at no charge, on a first-come basis. Infant/toddler life jackets are available at guest services (Proper ID is needed to secure these vests).
- Deep River Waterpark is a non-smoking facility.
- Be sure to obey the lifeguards and staff for your safety at all times. Deep River Waterpark reserves the right to revoke park privileges to anyone that disobeys park rules. The rules exist for your safety.
- If you ordered and paid for a catered lunch, let your group know that the location will be provided at check-in.

For groups with a reserved birthday party package:

- All participants in your birthday party must be paid for 10 days in advance at \$32.00 per person (minimum 10 people), as a deposit. If space is available the rate at check-in is \$37.00 per additional person.
- At any point, if your confirmed number of participants changes, please call Group Sales at 219-947-7850 ext. 604.
- Upon arrival, the group leader needs to check in at the Group Sales office. At this time, you will receive your admission tickets and pay for any extra people at a rate of \$37.00 per person, if space is available. We cannot guarantee the addition of extra people.
